

POKER CODE OF CONDUCT

Players must adhere to the Casino's Code of Conduct as failure to do so may result in the player being removed for the Poker area. The following etiquette tips should be understood by all players prior to sitting at a table.

Collusion: any attempt to share knowledge of cards or to play in a manner that is to the detriment of other players, will be considered as cheating and will not be tolerated.

Speed of play: Players are required to make decisions on their hand within acceptable time limits.

Card protection: Players must ensure they do not show their cards to another player. If a player becomes aware of another player's cards then all players must be shown those cards.

Hiding or removing chips: provided a player maintains at least the minimum table stake, a player may remove chips from the table between rounds of play.

Keep quiet/body language: During a round of play only English must be spoken. Players not involved in the game should be quiet and not comment on the continuing round of play in any manner. Players must also ensure that they do not display any form of body language that could be construed as communication with another player.

Integrity of the game: a player who sees an error made, or about to be made, must point out the error to the dealer.

Announcing your intentions: Players should announce their intention. All bets must be placed in one motion. 'String betting' is deemed unacceptable conduct.

THE ODDS OF WINNING

Texas Hold'em Bonus poker is a game of chance. The House margin for Texas Hold'em Bonus poker is 1.46%.

HOW TO PLAY TEXAS HOLD'EM BONUS POKER

The aim of the game is for your Poker hand to beat the Dealer's hand. There is also an optional bet called the "bonus wager", where Players compare their two hole cards to a payout table. Players need not win in the main game to be paid on the bonus wager, provided the wager was placed prior to any cards being dealt.

To play the game you must make an ante bet to receive your two hole cards. Inspect your cards without revealing them to the other Players or the Dealer. A round of betting will follow.

WILL YOU FOLD OR PLACE A BET TO CONTINUE

Inspect your cards without revealing them to the other Players or the Dealer. If you are not confident that your hand can beat the Dealer's you may fold by placing your cards face down in your box.

THE FLOP

If you think you may be able to beat the Dealer's hand, you may elect to play on by making a flop wager. This wager must be two times the value of your ante wager. The Dealer will then turn over the first three community cards known as "the flop".

THE TURN

You then have the option to check or place a "turn" bet wager. The turn wager must be equal in value to your ante wager. The Dealer will then deal the turn card.

THE RIVER

You then have the option to check or place a river bet wager. The river wager must be equal in value to your ante wager. The Dealer will then deal the river card.

THE DEALER'S HAND

After all Players have either folded or bet, the Dealer displays the House hand indicating the best possible five card hand from the two hole cards and the five community cards. If the Dealer's hand is higher than your hand, you lose both your ante and bet wagers. If you beat the Dealer's hand, you will be paid even money on your ante (only if your hand is ranked flush or higher) and bet wager/s. If your hand is equal to the Dealer's hand this is a stand off and you neither win nor lose.

WINNING BET PAYOUTS

ANTE OR BET WAGER	PAYOUT ODDS
Ante (only if hand ranker flush or higher)	1 to 1
Flop bet wager	1 to 1
Turn bet wager	1 to 1
River bet wager	1 to 1

GLOSSARY OF TERMS

"Ante" the initial wager that commences the game.

"Bonus" an additional payout made if you receive one of the hands listed in the bonus wager payout table.

"Flop" first three community cards that are exposed simultaneously.

"Turn" the fourth community card.

"River" the fifth community card.

BONUS WAGER

You can also make an optional bet called the "bonus wager". You are not required to win in the main game to be paid on the bonus wager, provided the wager was placed prior to any cards being dealt.

BONUS WAGER	PAYOUT ODDS
2 Aces	30 to 1
Ace & King (suited)	25 to 1
Ace & Queen or Ace & Jack (suited)	20 to 1
Ace & King (unsuited)	15 to 1
2 x King, 2 x Queen or 2 x Jack	10 to 1
Ace & Queen or Ace & Jack (unsuited)	5 to 1
Any pair (other than 2 x Ace, 2 x King, 2 x Queen or 2 x Jack)	3 to 1

RANKING OF TEXAS HOLD'EM BONUS POKER HANDS (highest to lowest)

RANK	HAND	EXAMPLE
1	Royal Flush	10, J, Q, K, A of the same suit.
2	Straight Flush	5 cards of the same suit running consecutively in face value, other than a royal flush
3	4 of a Kind	4 cards with the same face value and 1 odd card
4	Full house	3 cards with the same face value and another 2 cards with the same face value
5	Flush	5 cards of the same suit but not running consecutively in face value
6	Straight	5 cards of more than 1 suit running consecutively in face value
7	3 of a Kind	3 cards with the same face value and 2 odd cards
8	2 Pairs	2 cards with the same face value, another 2 cards with the same face value (other than the face value of the first 2 cards) and 1 odd card
9	1 Pair	2 cards with the same face value and 3 odd cards
10	Odd card hand	any combination of 5 cards, other than another poker hand mentioned in this section
