## HOW TO PLAY CARIBBEAN STUD POKER

Caribbean Stud Poker is based on Five Card Stud Poker, where you play individually against the House by placing an initial stake known as the Ante. You will also have the option to place a Progressive Jackpot wager.

Each player receives 5 cards face down and the dealer receives four cards face down and one card face up. Each player can inspect their cards and decide to either Bet or Fold.

If you feel you have a hand that will beat the dealer's hand, you may make an additional wager which is known as the Bet wager, which must be exactly twice that of the Ante. If you do not wish to place a Bet wager, you must Fold and forfeit the Ante and any Progressive Jackpot wager, if applicable.

After all players have either Bet or Folded the dealer will expose the dealer's hand and arrange the cards face up to form the highest ranking poker hand.

The dealer's hand qualifies only if the hand contains at least an Ace and King or One Pair or higher. Where the dealer's hand does not qualify the Ante wager will be paid even money and the wager on the Bet will be void.

Where the dealer's hand does qualify, the players hand will win if it is higher than the dealer's hand. If so your Ante bet will be paid even money and the player's Bet wager will be paid according to the pay scale.

*Payouts are subject to any maximum payout displayed at the table. These payouts are in addition to any Progressive Jackpot payout.

## PROGRESSIVE JACKPOT PAYOUTS

Before each game and prior to the dealing of any cards, players have the opportunity to participate in the Progressive Jackpot prize. To do this, place an additional Progressive Jackpot wager on the Progressive Jackpot betting area of the layout in addition to your Ante wager.

This then qualifies the player for a Progressive Jackpot prize in addition to the regular payments made to the following winning hands.

When a player has entered a Progressive Jackpot wager and has a hand that qualifies for a payout, it wins the Jackpot prize regardless of the result of the dealer's hand.

## THE ODDS OF WINNING

This card game is a game of chance and skill and is based on five-card stud poker. The house margin for Caribbean Stud Poker is about $5.5 \%$, which includes an allowance for the progressive jackpot.
