HOW TO PLAY ROULETTE

The Roulette wheel is made up of 37 segments, numbers from zero to 36.

The aim of the game is to guess in which numbered segment the ball will come to rest.

WHY ARE ROULETTE CHIPS DIFFERENT?

Some of the chips used on the Roulette table differ to those used on other games. Each player may be given a different colour playing chip (known as wheel chips) to avoid confusion when placing bets. The value of these chips is set by you when you buy in at the table (remember to exchange your wheel chips back to cash chips when you leave the table as they may not be played on any other table).

PLACING BETS

Before setting a new game in motion by spinning the ball around the wheel, the dealer will announce the commencement of the game by calling "place your bets".

To do so, simply position your chips on the table layout before the dealer announces "no more bets". Each player is responsible for correctly placing each of their wagers as each bet will be settled strictly in accordance with its position on the layout when the ball comes to rest.

When the ball comes to rest, the dealer will announce the winning number, and place a marker on it. All the losing bets are removed and the winning bets are paid.

Wait for the dealer to call "place your bet" again before putting your new chips down. Do not place chips near the winning number until the marker is removed.

THE RANGE OF BETS ON ROULETTE

Roulette tables have varying minimum and maximum bets. Before you sit down, please check the sign displaying the minimum and maximum bets at the table, or ask any of our gaming team for assistance.

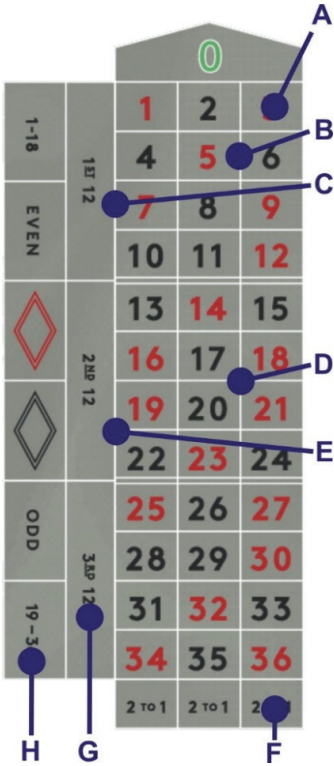
ZERO - THE LOWEST NUMBER ON THE WHEEL

When the roulette ball comes to rest on zero, all bets lose, except those placed on zero, or any combinations of zero with the numbers 1, 2 or 3.

ROULETTE BET TYPES AND ODDS

AREA	BET NAME	NUMBERS SELECTED	PAYOUT ODDS
A	Straight Up	1	35 to 1
B	Split	2	17 to 1
C	Street	3	11 to 1
D	Corner	4	8 to 1
E	Six-Line	6	5 to 1
F	Column	12	2 to 1
G	Dozen	12	2 to 1
H	Even Chance	18	1 to 1



THE ODDS OF WINNING

Roulette is a game of chance. The House margin is always the same at 2.7%.
